BRIDGING THE DOYLE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
2011-12 ACADEMIC YEAR

Application Deadline: August 1, 2011

This program provides financial assistance to qualified local high school graduates who are attending Santa Rosa Junior College full-time during the 2011-12 academic year to complete an Associate's Degree, certificate program and/or units necessary to transfer to a four-year institution. Funds for these scholarships have been provided by generous donations from organizations, businesses and members of our community.

- ▶ **Who may apply?** Students who are planning to enroll full-time (12 units minimum) at Santa Rosa Junior College who graduated from a local high school during the 2010-11 academic year.
- ▶ **Eligibility Requirement:** Unweighted Overall High School Grade Point Average of 3.0 or higher.
- ▶ **An official transcript is required!** Please attach an official high school transcript to your application OR submit your application, then contact your high school's registrar to request a transcript. Tell the registrar that it is for the Bridging the Doyle program. The transcript must be sent directly to the Scholarship Office. Transcripts must be received by the Scholarship Office no later than August 31, 2011; the scholarship application deadline is August 1.
- ▶ **When will you know?** You will be notified by September 2, 2011 whether or not you have been selected for a 2011-12 Bridging the Doyle Scholarship. We anticipate award payments being mailed September 14, 2011.
- ▶ **How will recipients be selected?** Scholarships will be awarded based on a combination of factors including high school GPA, financial need, high school of attendance, and field of study.
- ▶ **Award Amount:** Award amounts depend on scholarship fund availability; limited funds might result in some qualified applicants not receiving an award.
- ▶ Notify the SRJC Scholarship Office and the SRJC Admissions and Records Office immediately if your address changes.
- ▶ Keep a file of all scholarship correspondence.
- ▶ Make sure you sign and date your application. If you have any questions, please contact the Scholarship Office at (707) 527-4740.
